APPLICATION FEE

The non-refundable New Student Application fee is **\$50.00 (per student capping at \$100)**.

*Applications received during the month of August are subject to a \$100 application fee (per child).

* International student application fee is \$100 per student.

REGISTRATION FEE

Registration fees enable the school to purchase curriculum supplies for your child(ren), in addition to covering other non-personnel and non-facility costs needed to operate the school. This non-refundable registration fee must be paid at re-enrollment or upon acceptance in order to hold your child's roster position for the upcoming year. *The registration fee remains the same regardless of entry date. Multiple child discounts do not apply to registration fees.*

PAYMENT PLANS

To accommodate the FRCS family, the school offers the following payment options:

- 10 Payments: Ten equal payments August - May.
- 12 Payments: Twelve equal payments July - June
- 2 Payments: Two equal payments due in July and December.
- Discount Plan: If full tuition payment is received by May 31st a 3% discount is applied to the tuition payment. *Discount does not apply to registration fee.*

All monthly and semester tuition payments are collected through the **FACTS Management Company**. You will receive information on this program upon acceptance at FRCS.

MULTIPLE CHILD TUITION DISCOUNTS

- Two children: 5% off entire tuition
- Three children: 10% off entire tuition
- Four or more: 15% off entire tuition

Any student admitted during the school year will be charged a pro-rated tuition amount.

SPANISH IMMERSION EXPERIENCE

Kindergarten through second grade students have the option of enrolling in the Spanish Immersion Experience track. Tuition is \$500 for full time students and \$550 for homeschool students and part-time Kindergarteners. A \$75 registration fee also applies.

HOMESCHOOL PROGRAMS

Elementary students may participate in Homeschool Enrichment and 7th-12th grade students may participate in Homeschool Options. Please inquire for current rates.

PARENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

Realizing that our tuition rates do not fully cover the cost to educate children at FRCS, our school relies on charitable contributions and gifts-in-kind from parent partners to remain financially healthy. Upon acceptance into FRCS, your family will be asked to commit to one (or both) of the following:

1. **Charitable gift to FRCS** (Monetary donations are receipted and tax deductible. FRCS is a 501c3.
 - **\$500 per family**
2. **Serve in Parent Partnership Program between 7/1/09 and 6/30/10**
 - **60 hours per family**

If you have extenuating circumstances that prevent you from being fully involved in one or more of these areas of involvement, please notify the admissions office for assistance.

Tuition Assistance

FRCS offers tuition assistance to qualifying families on a financial need basis. Prospective families must go through the admissions process, *be accepted*, and enroll at FRCS prior to having their tuition scholarship application processed. Tuition scholarship applications are processed by an outside organization. Applications are available at the administration office.

REFERRAL CREDIT PROGRAM

The Family Referral Tuition Credit Program and Student Referral Award Program are incentive plans for new and existing students to recruit new families to FRCS. Your family can receive up to a \$2,000 tuition credit for each new family that you refer and who enrolls at FRCS.

SCRIP

FRCS sells merchant retailer certificates (SCRIP) to FRCS families. This program helps families offset tuition costs by allocating and accumulating a portion of money being spent for normal weekly living expenses: food, clothing, dining, and even gifts! Your total SCRIP tuition deduction is calculated once annually and applied to your account. *Prospective families can start their SCRIP account before they enroll at FRCS!
